Read stories to kids



- Don't just read books tell the stories.
- Use your voice: loud/quiet, fast/slow...
- Your voice must show emotion.
- Use different voices.

 What would Little Red Riding Hood sound like? Grandma? The wolf?
- Connect/interact with the story and the children.
- Let the kids see the book.
- Make eye contact with the kids.

Techniques:

- Stop. The kids say the next word.
- Ask questions about the pictures.

 What's this? What color is that? What's _____ in English?
- Make mistakes. Have the kids correct you.

 Oh, what a nice blue apple. No! It's red.
- Have the kids notice words, etc.

Who can find the letter "F"? What is this word? Who can find "dog?"

Have fun.

If you do, the kids will, too.

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
